RECYCLING DO'S & DONT'S

RESIDENTIAL CARDBOARD BUNKER - DO drop off all residential household corrugated cardboard - DO flatten all cardboard boxes - DO NOT leave cardboard in bags - DO NOT leave Styrofoam or plastics in boxes - DO NOT drop off any business or commercial loads of cardboard in this bunker, there is a fee and scheduled time for this drop off - DO NOT drop off soiled or contaminated cardboard such as, oil or paint coated and greasy pizza boxes, they are considered waste items

MIXED PAPER BIN - DO drop off all types of mixed paper, non-corrugated cardboard, such as cereal boxes, tooth paste boxes, etc., flyers, newsprint, brochures, coffee cups, etc. - DO empty material from bags and boxes - DO tear books and magazines into smaller sections and tear the spines out - DO NOT drop off mixed material items containing plastics or metals such as, coffee cans, other packaging material, tetra brick containers and dog food bags - DO NOT drop off soiled or contaminated paper products such as used napkins, or greasy pizza boxes, these are considered waste items

OFFICE PAPER BIN - DO drop off all white shredded and non-shredded office paper - DO empty from bags and boxes - DO NOT drop off colored paper - DO NOT leave shredded paper in plastic bags - DO NOT leave bags of shredded paper on the ground for us to pick up and sort

TIN CANS BIN - DO drop off tin and aluminum cans - DO wash and rinse your cans and remove your labels - DO NOT drop off other metal items, such as aluminum roasting pans, pie plates, car parts, eve's troughs, fire pits, stove grates, BBQ's, wire, etc. into this bin

CLEAR CLASS IGLOO - DO drop off clear bottle and jar glass only - DO wash and rinse your bottles and remove the labels - DO remove the lids and place those in the tin bin - DO NOT drop off ovenware, ceramics, mirrors, window panes, fish tanks and vehicle glass - DO NOT leave bags and boxes of glass and jars on the ground for us to pick up and sort

REFUNDABLE CONTAINERS DRUM - DO drop off all types of refundable beverage containers in the blue drum - DO NOT expect a bottle refund amount for them at this location

RIGID PLASTICS BIN - Do drop off solid ridged plastics numbered 1 through 7 only - DO rinse and wash your containers out - DO break down the material and sort into appropriate bins - DO NOT drop off plastic items that are mixed with other recycle materials like, metal, plastics and cardboard - DO NOT drop off food trays, plastic siding, swimming pools, tarps, eves troughs, car parts, children's toys and other plastics in this bin - DO NOT drop off soiled containers in this bin, they are considered a waste item - DO NOT drop off diapers and other waste items into this bin - DO NOT drop off film plastics or Styrofoam in this bin

FILM PLASTICS BIN - DO drop off clean shopping bags, garbage bags, shrink wrap, lumber wrap and furniture wrap - DO NOT drop off other types of plastics in this bin - DO NOT drop off diapers and other waste into this bin - DO NOT drop off soiled plastic bags, they are considered a waste item - DO NOT drop off ridged plastics or Styrofoam in this bin

PAINT TRAY - DO drop off all types of household interior and exterior latex, alkyd and oil based paints, varnishes, urethanes, primers, undercoats, sealers, enamels and stains and place in tray on deck - DO ensure lids are on securely - DO NOT drop off empty paint cans - DO NOT drop off used paint brushes, rollers, trays, sticks, gloves and painters cloths - DO NOT leave items unsorted in boxes or bags on the deck or the ground for us to pick up and sort

PAINT AEROSOLS DRUM - DO drop off all types of household aerosol spray can paints in labelled green drum - DO NOT leave unsorted in boxes or bags on the deck or the ground for us to pick up and sort

OTHER AEROSOLS DRUM - DO drop off all other household aerosol spray can types in labelled green drum - DO NOT leave unsorted in boxes or bags on the deck or the ground for us to pick up and sort

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE TRAY - Do drop off all types of residential household cleaners and chemicals in tray on deck - DO drop of residential household ballasts in this tray - DO clearly label and identify the contents of items - DO NOT drop off used automotive oils, filters and vehicle parts - DO NOT drop off large volumes of business, industrial, commercial or agricultural chemicals, please come to the office for assistance - DO NOT leave unsorted in boxes or bags on the deck or the ground for us to pick up and sort

PROPANE TANKS - DO drop off small 1lb propane tanks and place in the HHW tray - DO NOT drop off larger sizes of tanks, these go to the Landfill

FLOURESCENT LIGHT BULBS - DO drop off household residential small bulbs, long tubes, ballasts and place on the bulb holder and in the tray - DO stop at the office for business loads of bulbs, ballasts, as a charge of \$0.25/ft., or per item applies - DO NOT drop off housings and covers

ELECTRONICS - DO drop off all working and non-working TV's, monitors, printers, scanners, fax machines, laptops, CPU's, wires, mice, keyboards and printer cartridges - DO stop at office during regular business hours for assistance - DO drop off electronics on the deck after hours, weekends and on holidays only - DO NOT drop off microwaves, vacuum cleaners, toasters, hairdryers and other small appliances - DO NOT drop off air conditioners, humidifiers and water coolers, these go theLandfill

COMPOSTABLE MATERIAL BINS - DO drop off all household residential grass leaves, garden plants, flowers in grass/leaves bin - DO drop off all brush/branches in brush/branches bin - DO NOT put non-biodegradable and compostable bags in bins - DO NOT drop off noxious weeds - DO NOT drop off trees and branches 2" or larger, these go to the Landfill - DO NOT over stuff the bins, they are full when level to the top - DO NOT leave bags of grass/leaves, or branches/brush on the ground, this is considered dumping and is a finable offence

BATTERIES TRAY - DO drop off all sizes and types of household residential rechargeable, non-rechargeable, alkaline and lead acid vehicle batteries in the bucket and on the tray - DO NOT drop off large volumes of business, industrial and commercial batteries, please come to the office for assistance - DO NOT leave in boxes or bags on the deck or the ground for us to pick up and sort

TIRES - DO drop off all sizes and types off household residential small vehicle tires - DO stop at the office for assistance - DO NOT drop of business, or commercial volumes of tires, these must go to the Landfill - DO NOT drop off tires with rims attached and or the rims alone - DO NOT drop off after hours

CONFIDENTIAL DOUCUMENTS SHREDDING - DO drop off all material to be shredded at the main office during regular business hours (\$10.00/per banker's box) - DO NOT leave on the deck or the ground in boxes or bags for us pick up and sort

STYROFOAM BIN - DO drop off all types of Styrofoam and empty into bin - DO empty all bags and boxes in bin - DO NOT leave in bags or boxes on the ground for us to sort - DO NOT drop off plastics, cardboard and any other types of recyclable material in this bin

HOUSEHOLD ORGANICS BIN - Do drop off all household residential and business food scraps - DO empty all containers, or bags into bin #1 - DO NOT drop off dairy products, meat and bones - DO NOT drop off non-compostable plastic bags or containers in bin

PUT- N - TAKE - DO bring us gently used items such as clothes, shoes, dishes, books, furniture and other household items - DO sort and place your items on the shelf's inside - DO NOT drop off white metal appliances such as microwaves, stoves, dishwashers, fridges and freezers, these must go to the Landfill - DO NOT drop off mattresses or box springs, these must go to the Landfill - DO NOT bring soiled, stained, unsanitary, broken items, expired car seats, helmets and unsafe items - DO NOT drop off food items - DO NOT drop off electronics in the Put-N-Take - DO NOT drop off items after hours and leave on the ground, this is considered dumping and is a finable offence

SALVATION ARMY CLOTHES BINS - Do drop off all good reusable clothing in these bins - DO place all clothing in bags and drop into bins - DO NOT over stuff these bins, they are full when the traps on the doors will no longer take bags and close - DO NOT drop off bags and boxes after hours and leave on the ground, this is considered dumping and is a finable offence

DO be courteous to others that are visiting and recycling

DO come in and ask questions if you are unsure about what to do with, or where to place a recyclable item

Do come in and pick up a brochure and a RECYCLING DO'S & DONT'S sheet

DO come back and visit us often

DO NOT smoke anywhere on site

DO NOT speed, it is 10Km per hour!
